**Levels of practice noted in the Registry**

**1. Definitions as used within the context of the Registry**

1.a. Sound – Vibrational frequencies between 0.001-20,000 Hz which use air, fluid, solid and/or plasma as a medium of transmission and through which physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual health and wellness can occur more easily.

1.b. Neuroacoustic Sound Therapy™ - The use of vibratory Neuroacoustic sound principles and techniques developed by Jeffrey D. Thompson, D.C., B.F.A., through his work in Neuroacoustic Research to assist individuals to achieve a personal best in physical, emotional, mental and spiritual health and wellness.

1.c. Bio-Tuning®/Sonic Induction Therapy™ – The scientific use of precisely-tuned sound frequencies and scientifically-met nutritional needs to facilitate and achieve tri-fold health and wellness physically, emotionally, and mentally by bringing core belief systems into alignment with truth and thus supportive of the individual, manifested by a balanced Autonomic Nervous System of a participant.

**2. Levels of Practice**

2.a. Certified Neuroacoustic Holistic Sound Therapist™ –

- College or High School degree, with or without a master or doctorate degree in a healthcare field.
- Personal Bio-tuning® - has completed a minimum of five (5) sessions of the BioTuning Healing Phase, with all eight (8) recommended.
- Successful passing of Neuroacoustic Courses by a written evaluation, including the educational and technical training for the Automated Bio-Tuning® System and the modalities and advanced use of Bio-Tuning as taught in the Advanced Bio-Tuning Practitioner Course. Other Advanced Holistic Courses in Neuroacoustic Sound Therapy are highly recommended as offered and per interest.
- Internship served in person with Dr Jeffrey Thompson or Internship-at-a-distance and/or Webinars / on-line case studies with Dr Thompson.
- Successful passing of a Qualifying/Proficiency Learning Assessment.
- Observation and practicum requirements may be modified in individual situations due to licensure, experience, and/or use of the Automated Bio-Tuning System upon request and by approval of CNR.
- Commitment to practicing bop/Tuning® / Neuroacoustic Sound Therapy according to the standards and tenets set forth by CNR.
- Agreement to comply with the CNR Code of Ethics.

- Continuous Membership in the CNR International Registry of Certified Neuroacoustic Sound Therapists.
- Permission to use the following initials after his/her name: CNHST.

#### 2.b. Certified Neuroacoustic Sound Therapist™ -

- As above for 2.a. except as stated here.
- Successful passing of the Automated Bio-Tuning Course by a written evaluation, which includes the educational and technical training for Bio-Tuning®/Sonic Induction Therapy™ by attendance at the Course or by teaching one's self through use of the Bio-Tuning Manual and a study of the work of the Center for Neuroacoustic Research.
- Permission to use the following initials after his/her name: CNST.

- Awareness of research – Due to the interplay of research and practicum, knowledge of advances in the field of Neuroacoustic Sound Therapy and Behavioral Psychoacoustic Therapy™ is advisable, with special awareness of the high-tech, cutting-edge, innovative research and products at CNR.
- Ability to work compassionately and professionally with a diverse clientele of various ethnicities, religions, cultures, and symptom patterns.
- Sole use of the Vibroacoustic and Neuroacoustic products and works of Dr Jeffrey Thompson to enable recipients to benefit from results which occur with the Neuroacoustic balancing of the Brain/Autonomic Nervous System, as all sonic input come from one source.
  - Willingness to credit Dr Jeffrey Thompson and the Center for Neuroacoustic Research for the amazing accomplishments and game-changing contributions to society.

### 4. Professional Recognition is highly recommended

- The posting of one's Certificate of accomplishment and Membership in the Registry.
- Maintenance of membership in the Registry.
- The use of one's title as appropriate.

- Creation of a website noting association with Dr Jeffrey Thompson, DC, BFA, CNHST Diplomat which lends credibility to your work and gives proper credit to the inventor and researcher. ## **5. Membership in the International Registry of Certified Neuroacoustic Sound Therapists™**

- 5.a. An application may be filed when requirements for the level of expertise are fulfilled, as cited in this document.
- 5.b. A non-refundable fee must accompany each application. This fee is applied toward the first year of membership.
- 5.c. Continual membership in the Registry is highly recommended and is required to receive Registry benefits and recognition, including the use of any title noted in this document.
- 5.d. Biennial Dues are due and payable by the last day of the month of admission into the Registry. Dues may change without advance notice, but shall be reasonable and in alignment with other professions. Membership lapses 30 days later unless late dues are paid in full. The membership fee remaining from one level of practice may be prorated toward the next level upon approval of one's application for advancement.
- 5.e. To be re-instated, a statement of any changes in practice and other changes, as appropriate, and payment of one year's past dues, together with then current biennial dues, shall enable re-consideration of membership.
- 5.f. Professional Practice shall consist of Neuroacoustic Sound Therapy and Behavioral Psycho-acoustic Therapy according to the standards and tenets set forth by CNR, a vital aspect of membership.
- 5.g. Fulfillment of all legal and business requirements of one's country, state or province, county and/or city is the sole responsibility of each individual person/business. Compliance is highly recommended and will be assumed to be properly followed when application for inclusion in the Registry is made and membership maintained.
- 5.h. Adherence to the CNR Code of Ethics – Each person agrees to abide by the CNR Code of Ethics. Any complaint or misconduct will be handled individually and in adherence to the Code.
